

Immanuel's Music and Arts Camp

Immanuel's Music and Arts Camp is a week-long summer day camp where faith and creativity connect in a God-centered environment. The camp's mission is to offer the children in our community the opportunity to participate in a wide variety of visual and performing arts. Each elective will be taught by highly qualified teachers who will engage the campers in exciting and fun ways!

The camp culminates with a Friday-evening Closing Celebration for family and friends.

Core Curriculum

Daily Devo

This class will encourage campers to learn how to live peacefully with creation, self, God and others. The Bible is filled with stories that root us to our understanding of peace. Each day we'll explore these stories using our creativity and imaginations.

Art for All

Campers will construct their own handmade book with paper that they have printed, painted, watercolored or stenciled. They will also have an array of fanciful papers and materials to choose from to add to their own vision of "Peace: Make it!" The book will be bound with leather and recycled book covers.

Choir Time

We can sing peace! In choir, campers will learn fundamental choral and music skills in a fun-filled way. Music that is age appropriate will reflect the theme of this year's camp. We will team up with the Rockin' with Rhythm elective to make some exciting music that will be showcased on Friday evening.

Elective Course Descriptions

Campers in Lower Grades (Grades 2 & 3), Middle Grades (Grades 4 & 5) and Upper Grades (Grades 6, 7 & 8) customize their camp experience by selecting the electives they would like.* Each camper in these grades needs to select one elective from each of the three pairings below.

Primary Grades (K & 1) will have shortened class times and participate in all electives.

Choice 1

Drama

Discover the craft of acting and the collaborative process of making theater. Through games, personal discovery, storytelling and a TON of fun and imagination, we'll learn about acting techniques and terminology as well as other components of theater. This class will be geared toward both beginners and those with previous experience.

— OR —

Group Uke

This elective provides the tools to start playing songs on the ukulele right away. We'll learn tunes by The Beatles and other great musicians and lay down grooves and melodies as an all-ukulele band! Bring your own uke or use one of ours.

Choice 2

Rockin' with Rhythm

Campers will use hand drums, body percussion, chant and movement to create rhythms and express original ideas. Throughout the week campers will learn musical techniques, explore concepts and contribute ideas. The week culminates with an original group performance. Rock on!

— OR —

Yoga

In this elective, young yogis will experience stretches, poses, breath work, games and relaxation. We will play and explore in a non-competitive environment. We'll work on strength, balance, self-confidence, respect for self and others, as well as finding joy and vitality in our bodies.

Choice 3

Clay Creativity

Explore clay techniques and create a unique sculpture in this elective. Campers can make a useful bowl or a decorative mask. We'll sculpt, paint and glaze our creations and display them in the Friday showcase.

— OR —

Pieces of Peace

Here's an opportunity for students of all ages to discover the creative possibilities of music! In addition to exploring various styles of music on Orff classroom instruments, students will compose, improvise and collaborate with each other, focusing on music as an expression of peace within one's self and harmony with others. No prior musical experience is required!

Daily Schedule

The camp day begins at **9 a.m.** and ends at **3:15 p.m.** **All campers should bring a bag lunch each day.** Parents/caregivers are invited to participate in the opening and closing chapels. A closing celebration for campers, family and friends will be at **6:30 p.m. Friday, August 18.**



Enrollment & Fees

The camp is open to children who have **completed grades K-8.** Go to www.ilcsp.org to register online or download the registration form.

Enrollment and space in electives are limited to 10, so register early! A registration fee of **\$50 per person** will be required to hold your spot and will be applied to your total tuition fee. The registration fee is non-refundable.

Please send one registration form per child and one registration check per family.

Registration deadline, including fee, is July 31. No exceptions can be made.
