

# Open Questions

We are still early into this restructuring process, and have clearly not addressed all the issues. We are looking for help and guidance from the council, committees, staff, and congregation. Some of the questions we need your help with include:

- Should the Finance Committee, as organized today, be split into Financial Planning (part of the board) and Financial Operations (part of ministry)? In this scenario, the Treasurer may be a ministry team lead rather than part of the Board.
- Rather than having official (elected) Vice-president and Past-President roles, should the President be chosen from the Board? Could Past-President then be an unofficial role that acts as a mentor to the President (and perhaps not even be the most recent President)?
- What should our “Visioning Board” be called? Some options ExecPlus has identified: Board of Directors, or Mission Board. Suggested by members of the Council: Board of Trustees, or ILC Trustees. What are some other options?
- Will a four-year term for Vice-President/President/Past-President be too long? What are some other options?
- What should the term limits be for the Board? Should the Board set a policy of term limits for ministry team leads?
- What is the reporting mechanism for the Pastor to report to the Board? What should independent progress reporting from the Ministry to the board look like?
- What should the communication/feedback process regarding vision from the congregation to the board look like?
